# GETTING STARTED WITH CANVA

First, you need an account. Canva has a free and pro version to choose from. The free version is great for beginners who are just testing the waters. I recommend the pro version for serious digital product creators as it has way more features and benefits





Make sure you are logged into Canva. Start by clicking the link you were sent with your purchase




Click on 'USE TEMPLATE' and it will open up ready for you to edit







# UPLOADING PHOTOS AND VIDEO



### Uploading your own photos



Uploading photos and videos to Canva is easy!

- Tap or click the uploads icon
- Then select 'UPLOAD FILES'
- Locate the files you want to upload and select ADD

Then tap or click the uploaded files to add to your design


(You can also drag and drop from a mac)



Canva also has a HUGE library of photos and videos you can use in your designs. **Note - any that have the crown icon are only available for pro users** 

# PHOTO GRIDS


Photo grids are a great tool that will help you create a clean aesthetic to your design for a professional look





#### **CHOOSE YOUR GRID**

You'll find them in 'ELEMENTS' tap 'SEE ALL' to expand






#### **EDIT THE SPACING**

Adjust the spacing in your photos by clicking 'SPACING' then slide the bar to the left or right

<sup>3</sup> Drag and drop images from your uploads or Canva photos



# PHOTO FRAMES

Frames allow you to **ADD** or **CROP** images and videos into the shape of the selected frame




Canva has lots of different shape and style frames to choose from, including basic shapes aswell as phone and laptop mockups












#### TO ADD A BLANK FRAME

Go to 'ELEMENTS' then scoll down to 'FRAMES' (or use the search) click or tap 'SEE ALL' to expand

You can do the same with video!



# EDITING TOOLS



## **SPACING**

The Spacing tool allows you to increase or decrease the spacing between text and lines




## **EFFECTS**

Effects allows you to add some flare and make your text pop



(Here I've used the 'SPLICE' option)



## **ANIMATE**

This feature allows you to animate text, photos, elements or your entire design!



Select the text. choose

'ANIMATE' and choose from lots of options!

## TRANSPARENCY

This feature changes Animate Position the opacity of a photo, text or element




# POSITION TOOL & LAYERS



Each element, photo, text box, video etc on the page has it's own layer. You can change the position and arrange these different layers inside the 'POSITION' tool







# TO MOVE THE CIRCLE TO THE FRONT HERE

I have selected the cross pattern, Clicked on 'POSITION' and tapped on 'BACKWARD' to move it back a layer

You could also drag from the layers panel to re-order

With the 'POSITION' tool, you can also align different elements

# LOCKING DESIGN ELEMENTS



Locking design elements is a great way to keep your design organised and keep parts of your design locked into place so you don't accidentally move them when working on other elements

#### TO LOCK A DESIGN ELEMENT




Simply select the item you want to lock into place and select the LOCK icon



#### TO UNLOCK A DESIGN ELEMENT

Select the item you want to unlock and select the LOCK icon again




#### **HIDDEN TOOLS**

If your screen is low on space it will hide some of these tools. Just click the 3 dots to find them



# MAGIC RESIZE



This tool will save you so much time!



#### TO RESIZE YOUR DESIGN IN SECONDS

Select 'MAGIC RESIZE' and either choose a size from the list or add your custom dimensions

COPY & RESIZE will create a new design

**RESIZE** will change the current design



#### NOTE

You may need to make a few adjustments once the design has been re-sized

This feature is only available with a pro account





## ADDING HYPERLINKS

This is a super cool feature you can use to link text, images, elements or buttons to either a website, document or another page of your project. Perfect for if you have a huge document like a 'life planner' so you can make it easier to navigate





#### NOTE

You can also link text or elements to another page of your design. Instead of adding a website link, scroll down and choose the page you want to link to



### TO ADD A WEBSITE LINK TO THIS BUTTON ABOVE

Right click on the element and choose 'LINK' from the dropdown and enter the website in the box - hit 'ENTER' or 'DONE'


Now when someone clicks on this button from a PDF you send them, it will take them straight to the website you entered!

## TO ADD A LINK TO TEXT IN A PARAGRAPH

Highlight the text you want to link and the **'LINK'** icon will appear

# BACKGROUND REMOVER TOOL



Once of my favourite tools for professional designs!



## TO REMOVE THE BACKGROUND OF AN IMAGE IN SECONDS

Select your photo and choose **'EDIT PHOTO'** then tap the **'BG REMOVER'** 

#### **DESIGN TIP**

Create dimension by adding text behind an image. In pic 3 below I have duplicated the photo, used BG remover on the top photo and arranged the text layer to go in between + added a glow







# MAGIC ERASER





## TIDY YOUR IMAGES AND REMOVE UNWANTED PARTS EASILY


Select your photo and choose 'EDIT PHOTO' then tap the 'MAGIC ERASER'

Use the brush to to draw over the parts you want to be removed





## CHANGE ANY ELEMENTS OF A PHOTO IN SECONDS

your text here (8.5 x 11 in)

Select the image, choose 'EDIT PHOTO' and tap the Magic Edit tool

Choose your brush size and draw over the parts of the photo you want to change then describe what you want to change it to

On the images below, I drew over the papers and asked for "a bunch of white roses"





# MAGIC GRAB






#### GRAB SOMETHING FROM A PHOTO AND MOVE IT AWAY FROM BACKGROUND

Select the image, choose 'EDIT PHOTO' and tap the Magic Grab tool


Simply select the object you want to grab and drag it off!





# GRAB TEXT





### CHANGE THE TEXT FROM A POSTER OR IMAGE

Select the image, choose 'EDIT PHOTO' and tap the Grab Text tool


Select the text you want to change and either change the font or type something new

Note - This tool can be unreliable!





# PHOTO FILTERS AND EFFECTS






You can find lots of different filters and effects to add to your images - I have added some examples below

# SAVING AND SHARING YOUR PROJECTS

Canva auto-saves your designs in the app as you edit!



### TO SAVE YOUR DESIGN TO YOUR DEVICE OR TO SHARE

There are a few different ways depending on the format you need

CLICK THE SHARE BUTTON

On top right

**2** TEMPLATE LINK

Use this option if you want to create a link to your template where any user can edit the design - this will not change your original

3 CHOOSE DOWNLOAD


Choose download to save to your device. Canva will suggest the best format depnding on the contents but you can always change this

Options include: PDF, JPEG, PNG, MP4

**NOTE** - Choose a transparent background for things like logos!

# FILE TYPES & WHERE TO SAVE

- The file type you choose depends on the type of project you created. If you are saving an image or social media graphics for example, you will to download the project and save it as a PNG or JPG
- If you are saving a document or guide, download as a pdf
- If you are selling your projects as templates, or PLR templates (that your customer will need to edit), you will share the **template link.** (As show on the previous page and in video tutorial below)
